There are several types of presentations. Plenary sessions are 90 minutes long and are applicable to all conference attendees. A concurrent session is 60 minutes long and may have a more specialized topic than a plenary session. Panel discussions are either 60 or 90 minutes in length. Presenters should plan to formally present for about 40-45 minutes of an hour session. The remainder of the time will be used for an introduction and questions.
